### FATALITY ON VESSEL IN SHIP CANAL

As the steamer "City of Liverpool" was proceeding along the Manchester Ship Canal between Moore and Runcorn a steam-pipe burst in the engine-room, and the boiling water scalded Arthur Inman (30), of Ulverston, and formerly of Speakman-street, Runcorn.

The vessel was stopped at Runcorn, and Dr. Murphy was sent for, but the unfortunate man, who was terribly scalded all over the body, died before his arrival.
