# RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibits become the property of the Society for sale by auction at the close of the Show unless clearly marked **Not for Sale** with stickers provided.
2. **All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor personally**, except where otherwise stated, and any exhibitor not conforming to this rule will forfeit all prize money that may have been awarded and will be debarred from exhibiting in any future Shows.
3. The Committee reserve the right to inspect the garden or allotment of any competitor at any time before or during the Show.
4. An exhibitor may make more than one entry in one class, but no exhibitor will be allowed to take more than two prizes in one class.
5. Any objection must be made to the Show Secretary before 2.00pm on the day of the Show, accompanied by a deposit of £1 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
6. **Entry Form(s) in Section 1 and 2 MUST be delivered to the Show Secretary by 8.00pm on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September.**
7. **Novice Flowers, Novice Vegetables and Children's entries** can be made up to 8.30 on day of Show, but it would help if entry form(s) could be delivered to the Show Secretary by 8.00pm on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September.
8. Staging is from 5.00pm Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September. All entries **MUST** be staged before 08.45am ready for judging at 9.00am Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> September. Lighting will be provided.
9. No exhibit may be removed before 4.00pm. Exhibits not removed by 4.15pm will be auctioned off by the Committee.
10. The Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage done to the exhibits during the show, but all ordinary care will be taken of them.
11. All matters of dispute arising during the existence of the Show, not legislated for in these rules, shall be decided by the Committee.
12. If there is a tie on points it will be decided in the favour of the exhibitor with most first prizes. 1<sup>st</sup> prize 3 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> prize 1 point.021
13. Entries must be made on the form provided and delivered to the Show Secretary by 8.00pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September. Entries in the Novice and Children's Sections can be made up to 8.30am on the day of the Show.
14. Prize money will be paid on the day of the Show at approximately 2.00pm and presentation of trophies will be at 4.00pm.
15. Engraving of trophies by trophy winners is **NOT** permitted.
16. Commercial growers are **NOT** allowed to Show.
17. That artificial flowers and foliage be not allowed in any exhibit at the Show.
18. All Dahlias, Chrysanthemums, Gladiola, Roses and vegetables exhibited in complete classes must be qualified for the classes in which they are shown by (a) Classification and/or (b) formation and size.
19. Trophies **MUST** be returned to Show Secretary 14 days prior to Show, in a clean condition.

**Special Note: All judging will be to N.D.S. N.V.S. and N.C.S. Rules**

## **IMPORTANT NOTE TO EXHIBITORS**

1. All Dahlias and Chrysanthemums exhibits must be named (blank name cards are available on request).
2. In all classes where two exhibits of equal merit are staged and one is named, the named exhibit will be awarded first preference.
3. **Please Note:** That any class that is not well supported maybe removed in future years.
4. **Please Ensure:** That you collect your staging ticket(s) before staging your entry/entries.

An entry fee of £5.00 or over entitles the exhibitor to one free entry ticket to the Show.
