Is your ferret a winner?

Use the following checklist for advice and tips:

- **FACE and HEAD** - Hobs (males) have broader heads than Jills (females), but they still need to be in proportion to their body.
- **EARS** - Should be clean of wax, and ear mites.
- **EYES** - Bright, clear and alert eyes are important.
- **CLAWS** - Neat trimming is important, this is essential for pet ferrets, not so for workers who will keep their own nails short.
- **COAT** - This should be shiny, smooth and not dry. Do not bath!
- **TEETH** - Complete and clean, gums and tongues will be checked.
- **TAIL** - Should be straight and clean with plenty of fur. If your ferret has a rats tail please tell the Judge, it does happen to ferrets.
- **BODY** - Greyhound ferrets are long and slim, Bulldog ferrets have shorter faces. All will be judged on their overall appearance.
- **TEMPERAMENT** - If your ferret bites the Judge, it is not off to a good start! Ferrets should be easy to handle and alert, and should be aware of surroundings, ie sniffing the air.
- **MUSCLE-TONE** - A fit well fed ferret is the norm. Fit ferrets are not fat ferrets!
