LITURGY OF THE WORD

READING

A reading from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians 12:4-13

Brothers and sisters;

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but they all come from the same spirit. There are different ways to serve the same Lord, and we can do different things. Yet the same God works in all of us and helps us in everything we do.

The spirit has given each of us a special way of serving others. Some of us can speak with wisdom, while others can speak with knowledge, but these gifts come from the same spirit. To others the spirit has given great faith or power to heal the sick or the power to work miracles. Some of us are prophets and some of us recognize God's Spirit is present. Others can speak different kinds of languages and still others can tell what these languages mean. But it is the Spirit who does all this and decides which gifts to give to each of us.

The body of Christ has many different parts, just as any other body does. Some of us are Jews and other Gentiles. Some of us are slaves and others free. But God's Spirit baptizes each of us and makes us part of the Body of Christ, Now we each drink from the same Spirit.

This is the Word of the Lord.

CALLING OF THE CANDIDATES

Catechist: As Catechist, I call the candidates of St. Anne's to indicate their willingness to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. *(each candidate is called by name and stands. The Catechist then addresses the Bishop)*

Catechist: I assure you my Lord Bishop, that these Candidates have received the necessary instruction. I therefore present them to you to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Candidates stand

Bishop: Do you reject Satan and all his works and all his empty promises?

Candidates: **I do**

Bishop: Do you believe in God, The Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and Earth?

Candidates: **I do**

Bishop: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His Only Son, Our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the father?

Candidates: **I do**

Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who came upon the apostles at Pentecost and today is given to you sacramentally in Confirmation?

Candidates: **I do**

Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting?

Candidates: **I do**

Bishop: This is our faith, the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus, Our Lord.

All: **Amen**

Bishop: My dear friends, in Baptism, God Our Father gave the new birth of eternal life to his chosen sons and daughters. Let us pray to the Father that he will pour out his Holy Spirit to strengthen his sons and daughters with his gifts and anoint them to be more like Christ the Son of God.

LAYING ON OF HANDS

The people stand and candidates kneel in their places.

Bishop: All powerful God, Father of Our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit, you freed your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send forth your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgement and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence. We ask this through Christ Our Lord.

All: **Amen**

Candidates come forward and stand before the Bishop

Bishop: be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Candidate: **Amen**
