Background

- ▶ St Anne's Parish centre has been serving the Buxton community for over 140 years.
- ▶ Church groups, and the wider community, use the centre to informally worship, to learn, to fund raise and to socialise.
- ▶ The centre has been given several grants to facilitate refurbishment, demonstrating, each time, a need for this vital community space.

"For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them." Matthew 18:20

Current Status

- ▶ There have been some concerns as to the on-going viability of the centre, from a financial perspective.
- ▶ Financials, whilst accurate on paper, add no context to the income encompassing one off refurbishment costs and the challenges of the pandemic.
- ▶ The Community Centre, once sold, will be a resource lost to all future generations.
- ▶ Many additional possible uses for the space currently remain unexplored.
- ▶ Other similar community centres in the town are fully booked.

Counter Proposal

- ▶ Form a community charity to run the centre and cover management and administration costs.
- ▶ Provide a space for local community groups with a particular focus on activities promoting the arts and wellbeing.
- ▶ Running costs will be funded from letting income, profits from a community café, membership subs, donations and grants.
- ▶ Additional revenue will help to meet church costs.

Aims of the Proposal

- ▶ Retain the community centre for ongoing community use
- ▶ Generate additional funds to meet existing costs and generate additional revenue in the future.
- ▶ Create a centre which is focused on the creative arts, which is also flexible, inclusive and open to additional uses.

- ▶ Will the reduced parking meet parish needs?
- ▶ Are the church and community centre subject to restrictive covenants, as many parish buildings are?
- ▶ Will grant monies have to be repaid in part or in full, due to a change of use?
- ▶ As monies raised would be paid to the Diocese of Nottingham Trustees and are not guaranteed to be spent in the parish of Buxton, how do we ensure the parish benefit?
