

Initial proposals for the re-launch of St Anne's Community Centre, Buxton

At the last meeting between the PPC and the CMC, it was agreed a re-launch of the Centre under the new arrangements was a very positive idea. It would create visibility for the upgraded facilities, allow those who have provided grants to be thanked and provide an opportunity to celebrate the vibrant activities supported within the Centre. The CMC agreed to bring forward proposals for the PPC to consider.

We suggest:

- a) An open afternoon on a weekend in the Spring, after Easter. Specific date to be discussed.
- b) Invite all our Parishioners, sponsors, users, possible partners and anyone else from the Buxton community who wants to join us.
- c) Various scheduled activities would be put on to show what is happening in the centre. This could include, as examples, an art and craft mini-workshop from the art group, some drama scenes from Rec, some songs from Mad Hatters, face painting and a play area set up for children, unveiling of plaque and thanks to sponsors, etc.
- d) Tea/coffee and cakes to be provided.

If this general approach plus a date, can be agreed in principle then the CMC will progress the planning, make the arrangements and, with the PPC, publicise the event.
