

### ...to review your regular giving

Once again, 2023-2024 has been a challenging year with the cost of living crisis and buildings that need constant repair and maintenance.

We have though completed some important work by carrying out much needed renovations to the Sacristy, and creating a new kitchen, spending £3,225 with a further £740 in the first quarter of 2024/25.

Our available funds increased from £10,264 to £19,223, as we received a sizeable single donation receipt of two years gift aid and we now only bear 1/3 of Fr. Gerry's remuneration.

In July 2023 we welcomed a Ukrainian family to our presbytery. To facilitate this, we spent £2,350 to replace the house boiler and £1,248 on roof repairs. We have though received £5,000 from the government to help support the family; this support realised a small surplus but overall we expect a break even situation.

In the current year we need to redecorate the church and refurbish the pulpit, whilst continuing to carry out the work from the Diocesan Quinquennial Report.

# However, our offertory income is flatlining with an increase last year of 2.06% which is failing to keep up with the level of the cost of inflation, particularly on heating and lighting.

We face additional pressure in the current year as a result of parishioners moving on and we expect a reduction in annual offertory income of approx. £3,000.

So we are asking you to think and pray about your commitment <u>to give regularly and generously</u>. Can you remember when you last reviewed your regular giving? Now is the time to do it! Can you increase the amount you give? Can you commit to regular giving by standing order — saving on bank charges and admin? Can you Gift Aid your giving as HMRC adds 25% to your donation?

We are therefore asking everyone, including those who pray with us on the live stream, to please review and increase your giving to support our Church.
